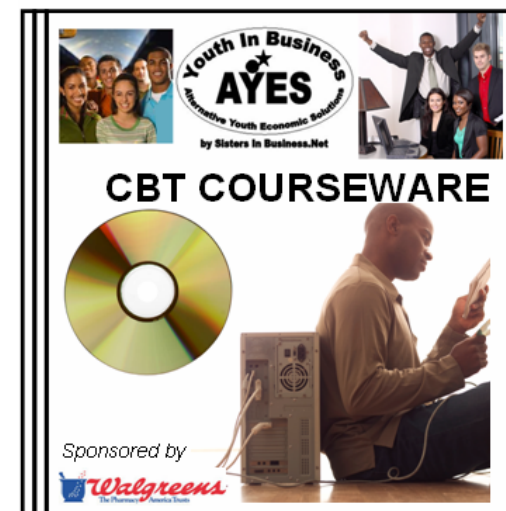


The program is currently being offered at Chattanooga State, where Mrs. Kelly is an adjunct faculty member, and also the instructor for the program.

What is Our Purpose?

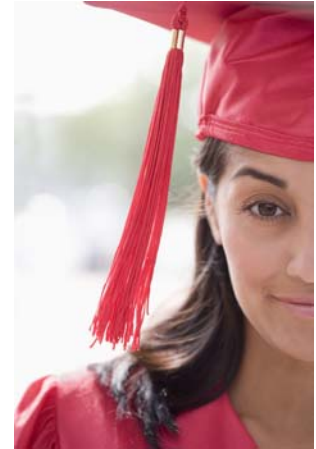

Volunteer job opportunities are also offered by YFB to provide on-the-job experience.

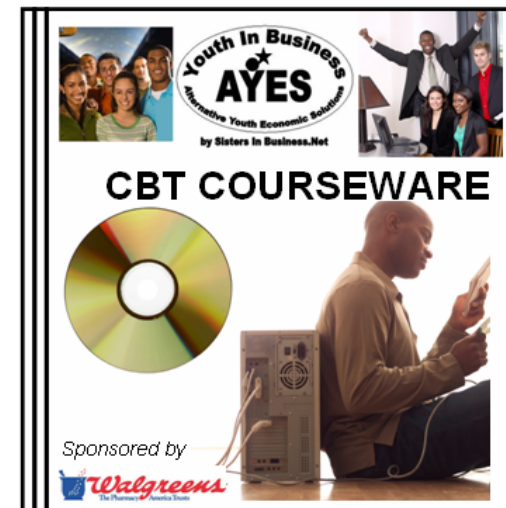

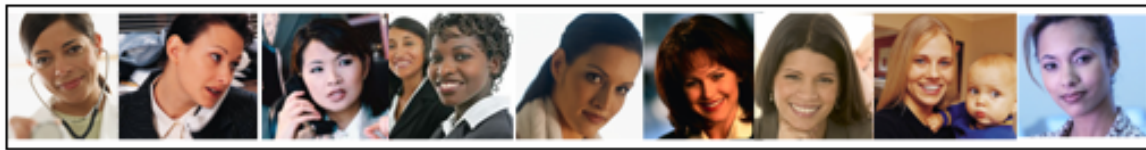

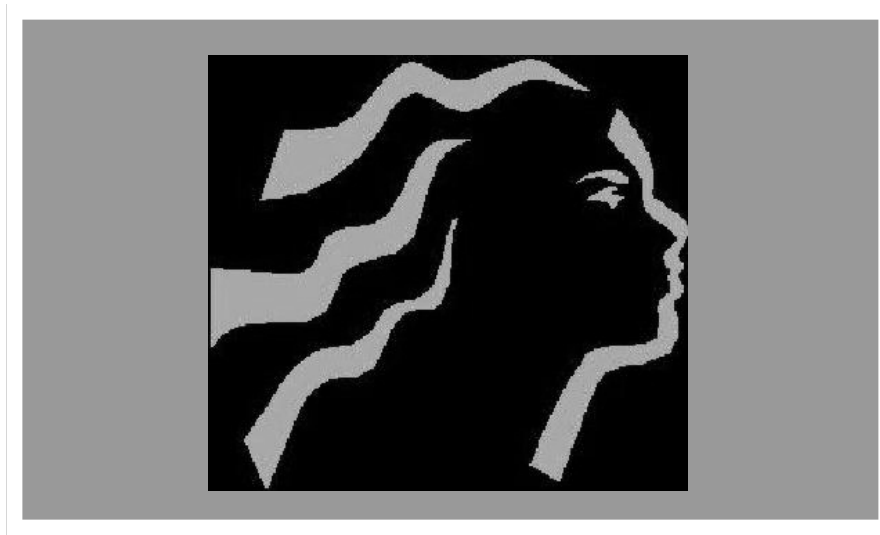
